You may be eligible for certain benefits:

Medical Benefits – Two options

1. Limited medical services through Student Health Care Center (SHCC)
 - a. Contact Jacques Roberts at (352) 392-1161 extension 4201.
 - b. You will need to pay an Optional Health Fee to SHCC.
 - c. You will need to provide documentation as proof that you are a CE student.

Student Health Care Center (SHCC)

The UF Student Health Care Center (SHCC) is an accredited outpatient clinic staffed by licensed, board-certified healthcare professionals who provide health and wellness care to UF students by appointment. Please CALL FIRST to be seen: (352) 392-1161. The SHCC offers general medical care/primary care (illness/injury treatment, immunizations, flu shots, sexual health services and more) and specialty care (nutrition services, sports medicine, women's health and more), as well as pharmacy, laboratory and x-ray services.
