Quality, affordable care is provided by dental students under close supervision of experienced faculty dentists in our general dental centers.

Fees are generally 30 to 50 percent less than private practice. Before becoming a patient, an initial screening appointment will be done to ensure that your dental needs are compatible with students' educational needs.

Because faculty supervise and evaluate each step of dental treatment provided by student dentists, treatment takes longer than in a typical dental office. If that works for you, and your dental needs meet our students' educational needs, this could be a great option. If your dental needs aren't suited for this educational environment, we can refer you to another care group where residents or faculty provide care.

Tooth extractions are performed for \$148 (exam, X-ray and one simple extraction). A limited number of patients are seen beginning at 7 a.m., Monday – Friday. Dental students treat patients under faculty supervision.

We have a full range of resident care groups where faculty and residents practice together. The residents have completed their dental degree and are continuing their education to specialize in one area of dentistry. Fees are generally 80 percent of those in a private practice.
